- 1. The gatekeepers had been assigned to their positions of trust by David and Samuel, (1Chronicles 9:22). Gatekeepers had to be reliable, honest, and trustworthy. We pray as Christians we live by these same qualities. Please pray for the shoe campaign and consider donating.
- 2. Solomon gave orders to build a temple for the Name of the Lord and a royal palace for himself, (2Chronicles 2:1).
