**Key scripture**-Luke 10:17-24..."And the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord even the demons are subject to us in Your name."And He said to them, "I was watching Satan fall from Heaven like lightning. "Behold, I have given you authority to tread upon serpents and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy and nothing shall injure you. "Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but **rejoice that your names are recorded in Heaven.**" At that very time He rejoiced greatly in the Holy Spirit and said, "I praise Thee O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that Thou didst hide these things from the wise and intelligent and didst reveal them to babes. Yes Father, for thus it was well pleasing in Thy sight. "All things have been handed over to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except The Father and who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son wills to reveal Him." And turning to the disciples, He said privately, "Blessed are your eyes which see the things you see for I say to you, that many prophets and kings wished to see the things which you see and did not see them, and to hear the things that you hear and did not hear them."
