- 22 "The manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all" 1 Corinthians 12:7. How many times have we said, "No thanks, I'll do it myself" when someone offers us help? We are given gifts to help others, Spirit of the Living God, you have granted each one of us many gifts and one of those gifts is receiving gifts from others. May we be gracious receivers of gifts as well as givers ourselves.

Correct us where we are wrong, give us unity of faith and thought, and grant us favor with the un-churched.

Nearly half of American children are born to a mother who is not married. Forty-three percent of American children live in a home where no father is present. Have you forgiven those whom you believe wronged you? It could be too late but it is never too early. Savior, help me to make the best use of my time and talents. Now!

- 18 "You shall come to know the truth and the truth shall make you free," John 8:32. What is truth? Jesus said: "I am the way, the truth, and the life, John 14:6. Jesus came to set us free, free from sin, free from worry, free from eternal damnation. Thank you, Jesus for you gift of freedom. Guide us to share your gift of truth and freedom with any and all who cross our path.
- 19 "I have found the Book of the Law in the House of the Lord," 2 Chronicles 34:15. In the Old Testament the country of Judah was deep in sin and idolatry when King Josiah found the 'Book of the Law' and began to implement its spiritual truths. Revival swept the nation. 'The Book of the Law' can do the same for you and me. Author of the Faith, help us to discover your, "Book of the Law," so that revival can sweep through us, our family, our church, and our community.
- 20 "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house," Mark 2:11. That is what Jesus told the formerly paralyzed man that had been lowered through a hole in the roof in front of Jesus. Jesus is telling us the same message. Jesus, we all have problems or limitations but You have restored and renewed us to do the tasks that lie ahead. Use us mightily to further your kingdom. We pray this in the name of Jesus, our Savior and Lord.
- 21 Today is Father's Day which honors fathers, fatherhood, and the influence of fathers on society. We shared earlier that forty-three percent of American children live in a home where no father is present. Children like these are more likely to become involved with crime. Heavenly Father, we pray today for those who are fatherless, for men who are derelict in their responsibility as fathers, and for the single moms who try hard to raise these children.
