Messiah, our best efforts to 'reform' always fall short without your input. Come, be our guide and our example.

- 25 "Jesus said, 'Let the children alone and do not hinder them from coming to me for the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these," Matthew 19:14. Jesus took time to minister to the 'kids on the block'. They had no preconceived notions about who Jesus was so they readily accepted Him. He wants you and me to do the same. Redeemer, thank you for loving and accepting us just as we are and for 'not being done with us yet.
- 26 "Be wise in the way you act with people who are not believers making the most of every opportunity," Colossians 4:5. At one time all of us were unbelievers and someone(s) witnessed to us either by word or deed. Whenever we are around other people we are 'on stage' so to speak. Teacher, keep us ever mindful that someone is watching us all the time!
- 27 "... It is not those who are healthy who need a physician but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous but sinners," Mark 2:17. The first step to being saved is to recognize that we are sinners and need a Savior. Jesus doesn't want us to just be members of the 'born again club' but to "Go into the world and preach the gospel to all creation," Mark 16:15. Jesus, you gave us our marching orders. - 28 "Accept each other just as Christ as accepted you, then God will be glorified," Romans 15:7. This verse makes me realize that I have my priorities out of order. Carpenter, help us build this school and graduate young people who love you and each other and have a 'can do' spirit about them.
- 09 "Unless the Lord builds the house its builders labor in vain," Psalm 127:2. How much wheel-spinning do we do because we don't invite the Lord to participate? Carpenter, we are good at building empty vessels. We invite you to be the Chairman of the Board in charge of building whatever we lay our hands to build.
- 10 "An anxious heart weighs a man down but a kind word cheers him up," Proverbs 12:25. An old Boy Scout motto is: 'do at least one good deed each day'. You and I can do that by calling, writing, or visiting someone(s) taking with us a kind word (or two or three). Savior, who needs a little cheering up? I would like to do that for someone today and tomorrow and the next day too.
- 11 "I urge then first of all that petition, prayer, intercession, and thanksgiving be made for everyone ... for all those in authority ...," 1Timothy 2:1,2. You mean I should pray for my president, senators, and congressmen? I am afraid that is exactly what the verse tells me. Redeemer, I haven't been good about praying for my government leaders. I ask forgiveness and right now, I pray for President Obama, Representative Collins, and Senator Guilebrand. Guide them to make quality decisions for our state and country.
- 12 "We are what He has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life," Ephesians 2:10. This verse boggles my mind. He created us for good works and then He created the good works for us to perform and, gave us the credit for them. Prince of Peace, you continue to amaze me. You have a plan and a goal that is beyond our comprehension. Thank you for being the God that has absolutely no limits.

- 13 "Come to me all who are weary and heavy laden and I will give you rest," Matthew 11:28. In this fast paced world virtually all of us are loaded down with cares, needs, and wants that put us in the weary and heavy laden category. But Jesus came to free us from our burdens. Jesus, here are the burdens that are holding me down _____, ____, I lay them down at your feet never to pick them up again.

Jesus challenges us here to have the heart and the means to help him/her across the street or across the world. Here I am, Master, use me.
- 17 "Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification," Romans 4:19. Our Savior must be saddened by the plethora of 'Christian' Church denominations. I am sure that there are very good reasons why new or different denominations exist. Yet, this is a testi- mony to the lack of effort and love that fractures us. Lord of Lords, forgive us our selfish and hard hearted attitudes and help us to grow together rather than apart.
- 18 "The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective," James 5:16. Let us remember that if we are "born again" we are righteous because of what Jesus did in our stead. Let us remember those who are troubled or weakened because of illness or injury. Restore them, Our Faithful Healer, quickly and completely in Jesus name, we pray.

- 19 The next three days the Sun Belt Expo will be held in Moultrie, Georgia. This popular and well attended show will feature, among many displays, our FCFI tent where folks can hear the wonderful story of grace and forgiveness through the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus. Raboni, use our 'walking stick' ministry to draw people to you and restore hope and faith to those who may be struggling with doubts or unmet needs.
- 20 "Commend them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be willing to share," 1 Timothy 6:18. This is Paul's admonition to Timothy to share with his wealthy congregants. The message is appropriate to us today as well. Creator God, you have blessed our country with tremendous wealth. Open our eyes to the needs of others and open our wallets and purses to help those in dire straits.
- 21- "They took offense at Him but Jesus said to them, 'A prophet is not without honor except in his hometown and his own household'," Matthew 13:57. Someone described an expert as one who lives at least fifty miles away. Master, we often discredit a person because he or she is 'local'. Teach us to value a person and their accomplishments because of who they are, not where they come from.
- 22 Romans 12:10 says, "Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each other," Colossians 4:6. "Don't criticize and speak evil about each other, dear brothers," James 4:11. Pastor, enable us to be good Christians every day not just occasionally.
- 23 "Jesus said, 'It is not what enters into the mouth that defiles the man but what proceeds out of the mouth that defiles the man'," Matthew 15:11. Many todays still have strict laws or customs that restrict what is to be eaten or drunk but Jesus was trying to teach us that what is within us, a clean heart and a pure conscience, are the important traits we should possess. - 24 "Get rid of all malicious behavior and deceit. Do not just pretend to be good. Be done with hypocrisy and jealousy and back stabbing," 1 Peter
