- 25 Many call this day 'Black Friday'. Shopping for the Christmas Holidays begins in earnest on 'Black Friday' and many stores open very early like four or five in the morning and offer limited bargains to the earliest arrivals. There are several explanations as to why it is called 'Black Friday.' My definition is that stores open before sun-up. We pray that no one is hurt in the early morning rush and that people realize that a bargain still costs money.
- 26 *"In the same way, let your light shine before others that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in Heaven,"* Matthew 5:16. That is a bright idea. May all we do or say glorify our Heavenly Father even if we are not the brightest light on the street. Heavenly Father, may we become less that you become more.
- 27 "Encourage one another and build each other up," 1 Thessalonians 5:11. Every person needs encouragement from time to time. Make a list of those you haven't talked to or visited lately. - 29 *"We should go up and take possession of the land for we certainly can do it,"* Numbers 13:30. This is what Joshua and Caleb told the Israelites in contrast to the report of the other ten spies. When faced with huge obstacles do we retreat with fear or do we turn to our Lord who is mightier than any obstacle? Savior, when faced with a problem there is

We pray a blessing on all our veterans and we thank God that they had the courage, fortitude, and willingness to face the enemies of freedom. On this day too we ask, Lord, that you protect all currently serving in our Armed Forces.
- 12 "Then God said, 'Let the earth bring forth living creatures after their own kind, cattle and creeping things and beasts of the earth after their kind, and it was so," Genesis 1:24. Our evolutionist friends postulate that living things some how got started from some primordial 'soup' and they are right according to this verse. But, they leave out the "God said" part. Creator God, how you formed all the animals and plants by saying so is an illustration of your power and ingenuity. Thank you for all you created.
- 13 Today is IDOP, the International Day of Prayer for the persecuted church. Take time today to pray for our brothers and sisters throughout the world whose very lives and lively hood are threatened on an almost daily basis and pray for the oppressors who think they are doing the right thing in threatening those with whom they disagree.

- 14 "And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive," Matthew 21:22. Some wise person said, "Be careful what you pray for." I would change that to "Be careful to pray" and let God decide how He and you are going to handle it. True Vine, we often don't know how to pray. Hear our longing and answer as you know best. Come Lord Jesus.
- 15 "Blessed are those who hear the Word of God and obey it," Luke 11:28. When I read this verse my immediate thought was, 'that should be so obvious' it doesn't need saying. - 18 "And He sent you on a mission saying, Go," 1 Samuel 15:18. Different language, different culture, different attitude, different climate, different housing, different food ... that is what many of our missionaries face when they "Go." Lion of Judah, help our missionaries to realize that first of all, they are doing your will. Next to experience your faithful and comforting spirit as they minister to people who desperately need to know your grace and forgiveness.
- 19- "I am not saying this because I am in need for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances," Philippians 4:11. Paul was thanking the Philippians for their concern for his welfare but that he had learned to

- 20 "He has sent me to comfort the broken hearted and to announce that captives will be released and prisoners freed," Isaiah 61:1. If you have been involved in the 'walking stick' ministry of FCFI, you have given comfort to the broken hearted and helped free prisoners. Chief Cornerstone, thank you for the 'walking stick' idea. Bless those who share your grace and bring needy people to the FCFI tent to hear your remarkable and life changing gift to all.
- 21 *"Therefore do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough troubles of its own,"* Matthew 6:34. Are you a 'worry wart'? I guess I am even though I know I shouldn't be. In one of our pastor's lessons, he told us that worry shows a lack of faith. And, it accomplishes nothing! Prince of Peace, forgive me my worrying. Guide me to place my total trust in you. My worrying has never accomplished anything.
