Greetings from the Fellowship of Christian Farmers, International! The 2016 commodity prices have been a difficult one for most of you. Despite these prices, corn and soybeans yields exceeded forecasts. We have much to be thankful unto the Lord. Scripture teaches that we are to experience joy in the midst of a trial; and that the trial will yield steadfastness.

The Fellowship of Christian Farmers responded to an August EF-3 tornado in Kokomo, Indiana. FCFI Board member, Dave Carter's farm was hit by the tornado. Ten acres of a 40 acre corn field was flattened. Amazingly, Carter was able to harvest most of the flattened corn with his combine. FCFI moved its shower trailer to Kokomo at the request of the Red Cross. FCFI Disaster Coordinator, Melvin Bell, is assessing the need in Livingston Parrish Louisiana near Baton Rouge for farmers to help rural families rebuild after 500 year flooding .

FCFI continues to serve Christ by serving others. In 2016 FCFI mobilized over 300 volunteers who served on disaster relief teams in North America.

FCFI's second and newest shower trailer is positioned in Tuttle, Oklahoma so it can be deployed in High Plains disasters. Lord willing, the ministry's command center toyhauler will be moved from Central Illinois to Central Oklahoma so it can be used with the new shower trailer. Samaritan's Purse donated the 38 foot trailer to FCFI for use in responding to rural disasters.

Your generous support is needed now, so vitally needed resources are ready for our Missions Teams to be able to serve and glorify Christ on the front lines of the mission field.

For the sixth year in a row, FCFI New Zealand has organized an exhibit at New Zealand's largest farm exhibition called Fieldays. Two staff members and six students attending Capernwray NZ Bible School are shown on set up day at the four day event: Over 4000 people heard the gospel message at Fieldays this year. Lord willing, FCFI will have missions trips to New Zealand for March and June farm shows. A 7.8 earthquake in New Zealand's northern South Island region called Canterbury, has greatly impacted farmers. Over 100,000 landslides have closed many farm to market roads. State Highway 1 north of Kaikoura is closed until "slips" can be cleared.

The Fellowship of Christian Farmers has added a second work trip to the ECHO International Global farm near Ft. Myers, Florida. Fellowship teams serve to repair and build facilities at the farm ahead of its International Conference each December. Reality Ranch in Florida is also a setting where teams work to maintain facilities used for youth rodeo activities. FCFI partners, volunteers, and leaders were a part of 100 farm shows and trade shows, as well as at state and local fairs this past year.

Thousands of people had a chance to hear the Gospel story including the power of Christ's love for them and how each person could know Him personally!



FCFI Board member, C. P. Foster, has hauled several truckloads of wordless walking stick material from Georgia to the Boys Under Construction Boys Ranch in Lampe, Missouri. The LUC Ranch serves as a walking stick depot for FCFI Chapters making plans to share the gospel at farm shows in the Midwest. Area Director Walter Powell in Omega, Georgia organizes the shipment of South Georgia material throughout the year. The Midwest needs another truckload shipped to the LUC Ranch as soon as possible. A truckload costs \$6,000. Your support makes it possible for walking sticks to be available at over 100 events in North America each year.



The Fellowship of Christian Farmers had a 30'X 60' tent display at the Farm Progress Show in Boone, Iowa, August 30- September 1st. Over 4000 wordless walking sticks were used to share the gospel message with farmers from all over the world. The wordless walking stick owner operator manual is printed in eight languages for the event. This year the average temperature for the three day event was 75 degrees---20 degrees cooler than normal Central Iowa temperatures.



The National FFA Convention and Career Expo moved from Louisville, Kentucky back to Indianapolis, Indiana on October 19-21st. The Indiana Convention Center was an excellent setting after five years of construction. Over 55,000 FFA members attended this year's show. Fellowship members shared the gospel with over 3500 students from across America. Your support enables FCFI to have a Christian witness at the National FFA Convention. FFA is the heart of America's future agricultural leadership
