FCFI Prayer Guide - October 2017

- 1. Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother, (Mark 3:35). Jesus' family did not yet fully understand His ministry. We pray to remember that our spiritual family is eternal while our physical family is temporal. We pray for brothers and sisters in Christ. We remember those who have been soooo adversely affected by Hurricane Harvey. We are grateful for all the volunteers who helped in the aftermath. We pray for continued strength for the long restoration process.
- 2. I tell you the truth, he (Jesus) said, no prophet is accepted in his hometown, (Luke 4:24). Even Jesus was not accepted as a prophet in His home area. We pray to present the Gospel and not worry that our Christian lives and faith are not easily understood and often not accepted. Please pray for Aaron who has walked away from the Lord. His Mom asks for God to draw him back.
- 3. Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now, (John 2:10). The miracle of water into wine
