

- 2. Then David and all his men took hold of their clothes and tore them. They mourned and wept and fasted till evening for Saul and his son Jonathan, (2Samuel 1:11). David loved Saul and Jonathan and was not afraid to show his grief. We pray to express our grief in turning to the God of comfort. Please pray for Anthony's daughter, she has health issues
- Solomon, your son, shall be king after me, and he will sit on my throne in my place, (1Kings 1:29). David was aged and near death. He declared Solomon king of Israel and had him anointed. We pray

- 5. The people of Judah were taken captive to Babylon because of their unfaithfulness, (1Chronicles 9:1). Although not every person in Judah was unfaithful, the entire nation was carried away into captivity. We pray to be a faithful remnant of the Lord God Almighty! - 6. Those from every tribe of Israel, who set their hearts on seeking the Lord, the God of Israel followed the Levites to Jerusalem to offer sacrifices to the Lord, the God of their fathers, (2Chronicles 11L16). - 24. Do not gloat over me my enemy! Though I have fallen, I will rise. Though I sit in darkness, the Lord will be my light, (Micah 7:8). Micah showed great faith personally and on Israel's behalf. - 25. *Nothing can heal your wound, your injury is fatal,* (Nahum 19). Assyria was powerful and powerfully destroyed. We pray to not lust after power but to pant after the Lord as a deer panteth after water.
- 26. *Oh Lord, are you not from everlasting? My God, My Holy One we will not die,* (Habakkuk 1:12). Babylon was a proud nation and served many gods. The essence of idolatry is trusting in ourselves. We pray as Christian to place our faith in the God who made us and help us give all we can in service to Him.
- 27. Seek the Lord all you humble of the land, you who do what *He commands*, (Zephaniah 2:3). Prophets announced news of destruction, but they also offered a way of escape. Turning from

One of the greatest kings of Israel fell because of the influence of unbelievers and he took others down with him. We pray to surround ourselves with Godly people and to read the Bible to keep God's truths in our hearts.

- 9. Mordecai the Jew was second in rank to King Xerxes., preeminent among the Jews, and held in high esteem by his many fellow Jews, because he worked for the good of his people and spoke up for the welfare of all the Jews, (Esther 10:3). Mordecai was condemned to death but because God is in control, he rose to become the second highest ranking official in the nation. We pray to remember no matter how hopeless our condition God is in control in our world. Please pray for our nation as we struggle through flu season and all those who have been and will be affected by the flu and the aftermath
- 10. Then the Lord said to Satan, Have you considered my servant Job? (Job 1:8). Job was a model of trust and obedience to God, yet God allowed calamity to come into his life. We pray in our tests and trial to express our faith and say Use Me rather than Why Me! Please pray for Henry's family as they have lost to death the patriarch of the family.
- 11. When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do? (Psalm 11:3). When the foundations of our lives are shaking we wish we could run away and hide. We pray to run to God in times of uncertainty rather than turning away from Him. Please pray for Robert as he adjust after being the primary caregiver of his wife for two years before she passed away as the result of cancer.
- 12. But whoever listens to me will live in safety and be at ease without fear of harm, (Proverbs 1:33). As we prepare our hearts through God's Word we are reassured of God's provision. We pray Lord, prepare my

heart, mind, and spirit to do Your will. Please pray for Tim as he awaits news of when he will be healed enough for surgery to undo colonostomy

- 13. Whoever loves money never has money enough, (Ecclesiastes 5:10). Those who seek only wealth and make it their god never find the happiness it promises. We pray to find our joy in the Lord whether we have little or much. Please pray for Ken and June, their house burned.
- 14. He has taken me to the banquet hall, and his banner over me is love, (Song of Songs 2:4). God is love and He loves His people. We pray to flourish under the banner of God's love. - 18. Do not be afraid, though briers and thorns are all around you and you *live among scorpions*, (Ezekiel 2:8). Three times God told Ezekiel to not be afraid to speak for Him. We pray for a boldness in our witness!
- 19. But there is a God in heaven who reveals mysteries, (Daniel 2:28). King Nebuchadnezzar was troubled by a dream and none of his wise men could interpret it, but Daniel with God's wisdom could. We pray for God's wisdom, so we may be able to reveal His greatness. Join us in celebrating the love of our great country and that we have the privilege of voting for the president of our choice...Happy President's Day!
- 20. In that day, declares the Lord, you will call Me 'my husband', you will no longer call Me 'my master', (Hosea 2:16). In exile the children of Israel began to come to their senses and turn back to God. We pray for a relationship with God through Jesus as our Savior that is deep and personal, as with a husband and not just a master.
