FCFI Prayer Guide - November 2018

- 1. The Lord said to Gideon, you have too many men for me to deliver Midian into their hands. In order that Israel may not boast against Me that her own strength has saved her, (Judges 7:2). Selfsufficiency is an enemy when it causes us to believe we can do in our own strength. We pray to keep our confidence in God and not ourselves. Please pray for David and his family as he and they adjust to the sudden death of Brenda, his wife.
- 2. Meanwhile, Boaz went up to the town gate and sat there, (Ruth 4:1). Boaz wanted to talk to Ruth's kinsman-redeemer in public, he knew this man would have to sooner or later come through the gate. We pray to wait on our kinsman-redeemer, (Jesus). Please pray for safety and sensibility as the holiday season begins.
- 3. After the Philistines had captured the ark of God, they took it from Ebenezer to Ashdod, (1Samuel 5:1). The Philistines had defeated Israel and captured the ark of the Covenant. Every place they took it God's hand was heavy on it and the residents suffered. We

- 25. Then the sailors said to each other, come let us cast lots to find out who is responsible for this calamity. They cast lots and the lot fell on Jonah, (Jonah 1:7). Jezreel means scattered. We pray not to be scattered but in unity with Christ and Christians. We pray for families to be reunited.
- 22. Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision. For the day of the Lord is near in the valley of decision, (Joel 3:14). Every day we go to the valley of decision. We pray for wisdom and strength
