FCFI Prayer Guide - January 2019

- Proclaim further, this is what the Lord Almighty says, My towns will again overflow with prosperity and the Lord will again comfort Zion and choose Jerusalem, (Zechariah 1:17). God had used other countries to punish His sinful people. But God showed compassion when the other countries over stepped their bounds. We pray to confront to restore and no more. New Year's Day... - 2. And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. If he does, the wine will burst the skins, and both wine and the wineskins will be ruined. No, he pours new wine into new wineskins, (Mark 2:22).
