2. *His glory covered the heavens and His praise filled the earth, (Habakkuk 3:3).* God disciplines in love to bring His children back to Him. We pray to be open to hear and receive God's Word for our lives. **Susquehanna Dairy Day, Elk Lake, PA, Doc DeVoe**
3. *Be silent before the sovereign Lord, for the day of the Lord is near, (Zephaniah 1:7).* The prophets foretold of future judgment and we, too, have been warned that Jesus is coming! 28. *My dear children, I write this to you that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense, Jesus Christ, the Righteous One, (1John 2:1).* When we feel guilty and condemned, we can remember Jesus is pleading our case through His righteousness. 29. *It has given me great joy to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as the Father commanded us, (2John 1:4).* The Truth is Jesus. We pray to give Christ the glory in our lives. **Please pray for Brenda, she has breast cancer and is taking treatments.**
30. *Dear friend, you are faithful in what you are doing for the brothers, even though they are strangers to you, (3 John 5).* As people come to know Christ as Savior they are our brothers and sisters in Christ. Please give and or support as you can.**
19. *But Timothy has just come to us from you and has brought good news about your faith and love,* (1Thessalonians 3:6). Paul had worried about his church plants from Thessalonica. We pray to be strong in faith and love. **Please pray for Lynn, she has lost her will to be a productive person and is choosing to give up on life.**
20. *We have confidence in the Lord that you are doing and will continue to do the things we command,* (2 Thessalonians 3:5). Paul was encouraging the Thessalonians in their faith. We pray to build each other up in the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ. **Please pray for those who are deep in addictions.**
21. *We also know that the law is made not for the righteousness but for lawbreakers and rebels,* (1Timothy 1:9). The law is to point unbelievers to Jesus. We pray to be the person who points others toward the love and salvation of Jesus. **21-23 3-I Farm Show, Dodge City, KS, Jeff Goss**
22. *But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, He saved us,* (Titus 3:4). There is much wickedness in the world but God in His love for us has overcome the world with love. We pray to be lovers of God and mankind. **Please pray for those who need the forgiveness of sins and love of Christ in their lives.**
23. *I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit for you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ,* (Philemon 20). Paul was asking for Onesimus to encourage his faith in mankind by accepting Philemon in love. We pray to be open to forgive those who have wronged us. **Please continue to pray for Chuck.**
24. *Let us therefore make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following their example of disobedience,* (Hebrews 4:11). God has provided for the Believer a rest in Him. We pray to claim our rest from trying to earn our Salvation and receiving it in conviction and commitment. **Please pray for Addi, a young child diagnosed with cancer and is taking treatments.**
25. *Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body but it makes great boasts,* (James 3:5). The tongue can be like a forest fire or a calming balm of Gilead. We pray to have a tongue that spreads Good News and draws others to Christ. **Please pray for KayLeigh, a 3-year-old with cancer, who is taking treatments.**
