- 2. You came out to deliver Your people, to save your anointed one. You crushed the leader of the land of wickedness, You striped him from head to foot, (Habakkuk 3:13). God's justice will prevail. We pray to take our eyes off our difficulties and keep them on God. Groundhog Day. Please pray for Peg Korn she had heart valve replacement. - 3. The Lord will be awesome to them when He destroys all the gods of the land. The nations on every shore will worship Him, everyone in its own land, (Zephaniah 2:11). - only ruins those who listen, (2 Timothy 2:14). False teachers love to cause strife and confusion. We pray to be grounded in God's Word and not easily swayed or angered. 22-23 Swamp Cabbage Festival, LaBelle, FL, Bill Brown
- 23. But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and arguments and quarrels about the law, because these are unprofitable and useless, (Titus 3:9). Again, Paul warns of foolish arguments among believers. We pray to not be the source of foolish and petty quarrels. Please pray for the people of China as they battle the Bird Flu.
- 24. I then, as Paul, an old man and now also a prisoner of Christ Jesus I appeal to you for my son Onesimus, who became my son while I was in chains, (Philemon 9-10). Paul based his appeal not on himself but on Onesimus' Christian commitment. We pray to remember our testimony goes before us. Please pray for Australia as they continue to recover from the devastating fires.
- 25. Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess, (Hebrews 4:14). Unlike the Jewish high priest who could go before God only once a year, Jesus is at God's right-hand interceding for us. We pray to be thankful for mercy and grace. Please pray for unbelievers that they will come to the knowledge and acceptance as Christ as Savior and Lord.
- 26. When tempted, no one should say, God is tempting me. For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He tempt anyone, (James 1:13). It is easy to blame others and make excuses for evil thoughts and wrong actions. We pray to accept responsibility for our actions and pray for God's forgiveness. - 27. Since you call on a Father who judges each man's work impartially, live your lives as strangers here in reverent fear, (1 Peter 1:17). We should not assume that our privileged status as God's children gives us freedom to do whatever

- 9. But when John rebuked Herod the tetrarch because of Herodias, his brother's wife, and all the other evil things he had done, Herod added this to them all; He locked John up in prison, (Luke 3:19-20). Rebuking a tyrannical Roman official who could imprison and execute him was extremely dangerous, yet that is what John did. We pray to speak out in the name of the Lord. Please pray for Naz. She has a bulging disc in her back. She has just gotten over hip replacement.
- 10. For this reason, the Jews tried all the harder to kill Him, not only was He breaking the Sabbath, but He was even calling God His own Father, making Himself equal with God, (John 5:18). The Jews could not see Jesus for focusing on trying to catch Him doing something wrong so they would have reason to persecute Him. We pray to seek Jesus and not our own agenda. Please pray for those who have recently lost love ones. Especially those who are grieving the death of a child or grandchild.
- 11. Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the Word, (Acts 6:3-4) Pastors need a faithful leadership. We pray to serve faithfully in the areas God has called us. Please pray for our President as he is having to make tough decisions for our country while he is under a lot of pressure.
- 12. No, a man is a Jew if he is one inwardly and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a Man's praise is not from men, but from God, (Romans 2:29) Devotion and obedience come from within... and should be heartfelt. - 13. Therefore, judge nothing before the appointed time, wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and 12-14 will expose the motives of men's

For when we judge, we invariably consider ourselves better. We pray to confront sin but not judge who is a better servant. - 14. Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness, (2Corinthians 6:14). Christians are advised over and over to in the world but not of the world. We pray to avoid situations that would divide our loyalty and make us compromise our faith. Valentine's Day. Please pray that as Christians we take notice of politics and vote how God leads us our country is at stake.
- 15. James, Peter, and John, those reputed to be pillars, gave me (Paul) and Barnabas the right hand of fellowship when they recognized the grace given to me. They agreed that we should go to the Gentiles, and they to the Jews, (Galatians 2:9). Each person is to share Christ according to their calling from Christ. We pray to open our hearts to sharing the Gospel wherever God sends us. Please pray for those who are victims of abuse in marriages and in committed relationships. Please pray for strength and safety as they try to find a way out.
- 16. Remember that at that time you (Gentiles) were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world, (Ephesians 2:12). Only Christ breaks down the walls of prejudice, reconciles all believers to God and unifies us in the body of Christ. - 17. But whatever was to my profit I now consider loss for the sake of Christ, (Philippians 3:7). Profit can equal to

- credentials, and successes. We pray to be careful in considering our achievements that they don't get in the way of our relationship with Christ. **President's Day. Please** pray for safety of our material blessings as temperatures plummet.
- 18. See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world, rather than on Christ, (Colossians 2:8). To resist heresy, we must use our logical mind, keep our eyes on Christ and study God's Word. We pray to be set free from deception of the mind. Please pray for those seeking jobs that in our time of up-swing in the economy they will find meaningful employment.
- 19. We believe that Jesus died and rose again and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in Him, (1Thessalonians 4:14). Death is not the end of the story. When Christ returns all believers...those dead and alive...will be reunited with Christ. Please pray for Barbara a good Godly woman and a friend to many. She has had a stroke and needs fervent prayer for healing.
- 20. We did this, not because we do not have the right to such help, but in order to make ourselves a model for you to follow, (2 Thessalonians 3:9). - 21. Do not rebuke an older man harshly but exhort him as if he were your father. Treat younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, and younger women as sisters, with absolute purity, (1Timothy 5:1-2). As we see people as fellow members in God's family, we will protect them and help them grow spiritually.
