FCFI Prayer Guide - February 2022

- And the Lord was gracious to Hannah, she conceived and gave birth to three sons and two daughters. Meanwhile, the boy Samuel up in the presence of the Lord, (1Samuel 1:21). - 2. The king (David) and his men marched to Jerusalem to attack the Jebusites, who lived there. The Jebusites said to David, You will not get in here, even the blind and the lame can ward you off. They thought, David cannot get in here. Nevertheless, David captured the fortress of Zion, the City of David, (2Samuel 5:6,7). David had been made king of all of Israel, many years after being anointed as a young man by Samuel for God. Jerusalem was the city he chose to be the place he would reign. Years of uncertainty dogged David, his only security was that God had anointed him king of Israel and so he stood on that. - 3. Even after this, (death of a prophet) Jeroboam did not change his evil ways, but once more appointed priests for the high places from all sorts of people. This was the sin of the house of Jeroboam that led to its downfall and to its destruction from the face of the earth, (1Kings 13:33,34). Only Levites were supposed to be priests...Jeroboam's disobedience was the downfall of true religion in the Northern Kingdom. We pray to follow God's guidelines in our lives. - 22. Then he (king of Nineveh) issued a proclamation in Nineveh: By the decree of the king and his nobles: Do not let any man or beast, herd or flock, taste anything, do not let them eat or drink, (Jonah 3:7). Jonah proclaimed God's judgement on Nineveh and the king repented and ordered the city to repent as well. We pray to simply tell others about God. We too, may be surprised by how many will listen. Please pray for our farmers as they begin the process of preparing for this year's crops. Everything they need to be able to put in a crop has doubled and tripled in price.
- 23. Her (Israel) leaders judge for a bribe, her priests teach for a price, and her prophets tell fortunes for money. Yet, they lean upon the Lord and say, Is not the Lord among us? No disaster will come upon us, (Micah 3:11). Judah was finally destroyed because of the behavior of its religious leaders and other leaders. We pray to not expect special favors from others because of what we can give...bribery. Please pray for Isabella as she continues to heal from recent surgery.
- 24. She (Nineveh) is pillaged, plundered, stripped! Hearts melt, knees give way, Bodies tremble, every face grows pale, (Nahum 2:10). Nineveh was thought too powerful and too large to fall, much like America today, she was ruined from within. - 25. - 7. This is what I found written there, (Nehemiah 7:4,5). The list of the exiles who returned to Jerusalem was written and stored in the Temple. - 9. King Xerxes imposed tribute throughout the empire, to its distant shores. And all his acts of power and might, together with a full account of the greatness of Mordecai, (Esther 10:1,2). - 10. I loathe my very life; therefore, I will give free rein to my complaint and speak out in the bitterness of my soul, (Job 10:1). - 13. - 14. Learn to do right! Seek justice, encourage the oppressed. Defend the cause of the fatherless, plead the case of the widow, (Isaiah 1:17). As Christians we are to be helpers of the less fortunate. We pray to encourage, defend and plead for those in need. Pray that we would love others through the power of the Holy Spirit. - 15. My people have committed two sins: They have forsaken Me, the spring of living water, and have dug their own cisterns, broken cisterns that cannot hold water, (Jeremiah 2:13). - 17. While they were killing (at Gods command) and I (Ezekiel) was left alone, I fell facedown, crying out, O, Sovereign Lord!
