Disaster Relief Campaigns

The Fellowship has been active in Marshall County Kentucky since the December 10, 2021 tornado. Eighteen farms have been helped and much more long-term disaster work remains. Hurricane Ida hit Baton Rouge area of Louisiana in 2021. Disaster Coordinator, Mike Weaver, worked with the Louisiana Cattleman's Association in Amite, Louisiana. FCFI involvement helping Ukraine refuges and orphans

FCFI President Steve Cernek and his daughter were part of an FCFI mission trip to Romania to help Clark and Sue Phillips build a 150 cow dairy called Caminul Felix. Steve returned to Romania 16 years in a row cultivating relationships with Romania churches and Pastors. When the war in Ukraine

broke out Steve made a call to Pastor Alex to learn that Ukrainian Orphans were on their way to Romania from Kiev to live in the church's Christian camping facilities. Steve Cernek's testimony was written in Profit magazine. Pastor Alex from Romania will be with us at the 29th Annual Conference and will be one of our speakers! FCFI has been very careful not to share specific information or photos about the orphans. Please pray for Pastor Alex's church to provide care for refuges and orphans.
