FCFI Prayer Guide - July 2022

1. *You have disobeyed Me. Why have you done this? Now therefore, I tell you that I (God) will not drive them (Canaanites) out before you, they will be thorns in your sides and their gods will be a snare to you, (Judges 2:3). The Israelites did not obey God when they let the Canaanites live among them in Canaan Even though God honored His part of the Covenant, the Israelites didn't so God took his hand of protection away from them because of their disobedience. We pray to be a people of obedience. **1-9 Millville Carnival, Doc Devoe***
2. *Then Boaz announced to the elders and all the people, today you are witnesses that I have bought from Naomi all the property of Elimelech, Kilion, and Mahlon. I have also acquired Ruth the Moabitess, Mahlon's widow, as my wife, in order to maintain the name of the dead with his property so that his name will not disappear from among his family or from the town records. Today you are witnesses, (Ruth 4:9-10). Because of Ruth's faithful obedience, her life was significant in the lineage of David and of Jesus. She could not have imagined how her life and legacy would impact future generations for good even to this day. We pray to think beyond the sacrifices we many have to make today to see the rewards in the future. **Please pray for the family of Milton Rousey, he passed away suddenly after a short bout with cancer.***
3. *Now Jesse said to his son David, Take this ephah of roasted grain and these ten loaves of bread for your brothers and hurry to their camp. Take along these ten cheeses to the commander of their unit. See how your brothers are and bring back some assurance from them. They are with*

*Saul and all the men of Israel in the Valley of Elah, fighting against the Philistines, (1Samuel 17:17-19). David was Jesse's youngest son and had been anointed by Samuel at God's request to be the next king of Israel. David did not walk in fear...God had him in place to show us that the Goliath's of the world are no match for our God of the Angel Armies. We pray to be fearless in stepping up for God. **Please pray for the family of Shelia Jones, she passed away after a long battle with cancer.***

4. *Then David got up from the ground. After he had washed, put on lotions and changed his clothes, he went into the house of the Lord and worshipped. Then he went to his own house, and at his request they served him food, and he ate, (2 Samuel 12:20-21). David had sinned and his child died as the consequences of that sin. He didn't blame God, rather he worshipped and began life over again. We pray to know all sin has consequences. **Please pray for the families of Pete and Sandy Singer, workers of FCFI, their families are getting attacks from Satan.***
5. *So Zadok the priest, Nathan the prophet, Benaiah son of Jehoiada, the Kerethites and the Pelethites went down and put Solomon on King David's mule and escorted him to Hihon. Zadok the priest took the horn of oil from the sacred tent and anointed Solomon. Then they sounded the trumpet and all the people shouted, Long Live King Solomon! And all the people went up after him, playing flutes and rejoicing greatly, so that the ground shook with the sound, (1 Kings 1:38-40). David's sons were competing as to who would be king when their father died. David obeyed God's decree and backed Solomon and had him anointed and crowned. We pray to be faithful to God's Word. **Please pray for Cheyann, a young girl who has had multiple surgeries to build her a chin, she continues to need prayer.***
6. *An officer of the king of Israel answered, Elisha son of Shaphat is here. He used to pour water on the hands of Elijah, (2 Kings 3:11). Elisha's testimony was that he was the personal servant of Elijah. We pray to remember who we associate with makes a difference. **Please pray for Tom as he continues to heal from a heart attack and bypass surgery.***
7. *These were the chiefs of David's mighty men, they, together with all Israel gave his kingship strong support to extend it over the whole land, as the Lord had promised, (1 Chronicles 11:10). David had mighty men of valor who surrounded him. We pray to have spiritual people of valor surround us. **Please pray for Chloe, she recently had surgery.***

29. *Therefore, as surely as I live, declares the Lord Almighty, the God of Israel, surely Moab will become like Sodom, the Ammonites like Gomorrah, a place of weeds and salt pits, a wasteland forever. The remnant of My people will plunder them, the survivors of My nation will inherit their land, (Zephaniah 2:9). The nations mentioned had not been kind to Israel and God was answering their actions with actions of His own. We pray to remember Israel is God's chosen land with His chosen people. **Please pray for the young adults in our society...many have no idea the sacrifices made so their lives can be comfortable. Please pray specifically for them to be able to handle what life will throw their way.***
30. *So the Lord stirred up the Spirit of Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the Spirit of Joshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the Spirit of the whole remnant of the people They came and began to work on the house of the Lord Almighty, their God, on the twenty-fourth day of the sixth month in the second year of King Darius, (Haggai 1:14-15). This remnant of people put their faith into action and began to rebuild the Temple. We pray to be a people of action as God calls us to duty. **Please pray for our missionaries, here at home and abroad.***
31. *And the Word of the Lord came again to Zechariah: This is what the Lord Almighty says: Administer true justice, show mercy and compassion to one another, (Zechariah 7:8). We should worship in Spirit and in truth, not out of habit and ritual. We pray to have the Spirit of justice, mercy and compassion as we worship and live our lives. **Please pray for rain in the South.***

those who sit in Samaria on the edge of their beds and in Damascus on their couches, (Amos 3:12). God, even in His judgement always saved a remnant of Israel. 24. *If thieves came to you, if robbers in the night, Oh, what a disaster awaits you, would they not steal only as much as they wanted? If grape pickers came to you, would they not leave a few grapes?* (Obadiah 5). The nation of Israel descended from Jacob, the nation of Edom descended from Esau, Jacob's twin brother. Edom would not let the Israelites pass through their land earlier and now God was judging them because of His beloved people. We pray to be people of little conflict. **Please pray for those who are continuing to have Covid.**
25. *Jonah went out and sat down at a place east of the city (Nineveh),* (Jonah 4:5). Jonah had rebelled and then had fulfilled his calling to preach to the people of Nineveh, it was not his place to be the judge of the people nor of God. He should have gone home and let his witness speak for itself. We pray to understand God feels compassion to the sinners we want judged. **25-30 Troy Fair, Troy, PA, Michael Steele**
26. *But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for Me One who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times,* (Micah 5:2). Micah predicted the birthplace of Jesus hundreds of years before the Messiah was born. We pray to be well schooled in God's Word and stand firm on our understanding. **Please pray for Salvation for many through the sharing of the beads and the walking sticks.**
27. *Celebrate your festivals, O Judah, and fulfill your vows. No more will the wicked invade you, they will be completely destroyed,* (Nahum 1:15). 9. *Then the family heads of Judah and Benjamin, and the priests and Levites, everyone whose heart God had moved, prepared to go up and build the house of the Lord in Jerusalem,* (Ezra 1:5). The people had been captive for 48 years and most didn't want to change their lifestyle. The hearts of those who were moved to return to Jerusalem and rebuild the Temple gathered their supplies. 10. *I (Nehemiah) went to Jerusalem, and after staying there three days I set out during the night with a few men. I had not told anyone what my God has put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. 14. *The fear (respect) of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline, (Proverbs 1:7).* Obnoxious know-it-alls are not open to wisdom. We pray to learn how to learn and to love being taught. **11-15 Texas State FFA Convention, Dallas, Jeff Goss**

15. *How beautiful you are, my darling! Oh, how beautiful! Your eyes are doves, (Song of Solomon 1:15).* An oasis of love is all the more beautiful because of the starkness of reality surrounding it. 18. *Bitterly she weeps at night, tears are upon her cheeks. Among all her lovers there is none to comfort her. All her friends have betrayed her, they have become her enemies, (Lamentations 1:2).* Jeremiah mourns

for Jerusalem. We pray to mourn for our unbelieving friends and call out to God for them. **13-23 Lycoming County Fair, Hughesville, PA, Doc DeVoe**

19. *The Word of the Lord came to me (Ezekiel): son of man, you are living among a rebellious people. They have eyes to see but do not see and ears to hear but do not hear, for they are a rebellious people, (Ezekiel 12:1).* When Ezekiel warned the people of their rebellious way, they refused to listen and were later captured. We pray to listen to the Word of the Lord and not follow our own rebellious heart. **Please pray for our farmers!!!**

20. *Then the king (Nebuchadnezzar) ordered Ashpenaz, chief of his court officials, to bring in some of the Israelites from the royal family and the nobility, young men without any physical defect, handsome, showing aptitude for every kind of learning, well informed, quick to understand, and qualified to serve in the king's palace. He was to teach them the language and literature of the Babylonians. The king assigned them a daily amount of food and wine from the king's table. They were to be trained for three years, and after that they were to enter the king's service, (Daniel 1:3-5).* Conquered but not subdued, Daniel and his friends were an example to all to let our God light shine where we are. We pray to let our Jesus light shine out into the world around us. **Please pray for the family of sweet little Addie Bell...a six-year-old who died suddenly.**

21. *In that day I will make a covenant for them with the beasts of the field and the birds of the air and the creatures that move along the ground. Bow and sword and battle I will abolish from the land, so that all may lie down in safety, (Hosea 2:18).* God was promising a fresh new beginning, not just a temporary rewriting of a tired old agreement. We pray to see and feel God's great love and compassion and to show that to others. **Please pray for Carson...a young boy with Leukemia...he seems to be losing this battle.**

22. *Before them (Locust) fire devours, behind them a flame blazes. Before them the land is like the garden of Eden, behind them, a desert waste, nothing escapes them, (Joel 2:3).* A plague of locust was just the beginning of the destruction Israel would feel before they turned back to their God. We pray to be thankful for God's great love and compassion. **Please pray for a baby invitro who has a mass on one lung.**

23. *This is what the Lord says: As a shepherd saves from the lion's mouth only two leg bones or a piece of an ear, so will the Israelites be saved,*
