FCFI Prayer Guide - September 2022

- 1. When the Israelites cried to the Lord because of Midian, He sent a prophet, who said, This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: I brought you up out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. I snatched you from the power of Egypt and from the hand of all your oppressors. I drove them from before you and gave you their land. I said to you, I am the Lord you God, do not worship the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you live, (Judges 6:7-10). These people were descendants of Abraham's second wife and were always at odds with Israel. Disobedience always brings confusion. - 2. When the time drew near for David to die, he gave a charge to Solomon his son. I am about to go the way of all the earth, he said. So be strong, show yourself a man, and observe what the Lord your God requires. Walk in His ways and keep His decrees and commands, His laws and requirements, as written in the Law of Moses, so that you may prosper in all you do and wherever you go and that the Lord may keep His promise to me, (1Kings 2:1-4). God had promised David his descendants would go on forever... keeping God in the center of his life was something Solomon would have to choose. - 3. Elisha said to Gehazi, Tuck your cloak into your belt, take my staff

in your hand and run. If you meet anyone, do not greet him, and if anyone greets you, do not answer. Lay my staff on the boy's face, (2Kings 4:29). The Shunammite woman's child was dead and she came straight to Elisha, the person of power, the prophet of God. - 4. These are the men David put in charge of the music in the house of the Lord after the ark came to rest there. They ministered with music before the tabernacle, the Tent of Meeting, until Solomon built the temple of the Lord in Jerusalem. They performed their duties according to the regulations laid down for them, (1Chronicles 6:1-32). The first worship leaders were charged here. They used their talents to glorify God. - 5. Solomon took a census of all the aliens who were in Israel, after the census his father David had taken: and they were found to be 153,000. He assigned 70,000 of them to be carriers and 80,000 of them to be stone cutters in the hills with 3600 foremen over them to keep the people working, (2Chronicles 2:17-18). Solomon was about to start building the Temple in Jerusalem. These aliens were people taken captive while the land was being captured and filled with Israelites. - 6. When the seventh month came and the Israelites had settled in their towns, the people assembled as one man in Jerusalem, (Ezra 3:1). The people had been in exile and the Temple torn down. - 30. Brothers, I can tell you confidently that the patriarch David died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day. But he was a prophet and knew that God had promised him on oath that He would place one of his descendants on his throne. Seeing what was ahead, he spoke of the resurrection for the Christ, that He was not abandoned to the grave, nor did His body see decay, (Acts 2:29-31). Peter had a great message that included a quote for Psalms from King David. We pray to know our Bible and believe the words in it and use it to reach others with confidence. Please pray for grace and mercy our country that we would experience a revival!!!!

- 23. The Lord within her (Jerusalem) is righteous, He does no wrong. Morning by morning He dispenses His justice and every new day He does not fail, yet the unrighteous know no shame, (Zephaniah 3:5).
