- 1. The men (spies) said to her (Rahab), this oath you made us swear will not be binding on us unless, when we enter the land, you have tied this scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down and unless you have brought your father and mother, your brothers and all your family into your house, (Joshua 2:17,18). Rahab had seen the evidence that the God of the Israelites was real and asked for protection when her town was to be invaded...the spies told her to tie the red cord in her window and she and her family would be saved.
