FCFI Prayer Guide - February 2024

- 1. Have you not brought this on yourselves by forsaking the Lord your God when he led you in the way, (Jeremiah 2:17). Israel had seen many miracles, yet they still forsook their God. - 2. For men are not cast off by the Lord forever, (Lamentations 3:31). Grief and suffering come to us all...sometimes by our own fault. God is faithful to rescue us when we call out to Him. - 3. He (the messenger of God) then said to me: Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak my words to them. You are not being sent to a people of obscure speech and difficult language, but to the house of Israel, (Ezekiel 3:4-5). Ezekiel was called to warn his own people of their sins.
