- 1. The angel answered, "I am Gabriel. I stand in the presence of God, and I have been sent to speak to you and to tell you this good news. And now you will be silent and not able to speak until the day this happens, because you did not believe my words, which will come true to their proper times, (Luke 1:19,20). - 2. Nazareth! Can anything good come from there? Nathanael asked. Come and see, said Philip. - and all who belong to them, and that you will save us from death, (Joshua 2:12,13). Rahab was a remarkable woman. She heard the truth and believed it. And acted on it. - 26. When Boaz had finished eating and drinking and was in good spirits, he went over to lie down at the far end of the grain pile. Ruth approached quietly, uncovered his feet, and lay down. In the middle of the night something startled the man, and he turned and discovered a woman lying at his feet. Who are you? He asked, (Ruth 3:7-9). - 12. The sins of some men are obvious, reaching the place of judgment ahead of them, the sins of others trail behind them. In the same way, good deeds are obvious, and even those that are not cannot be hidden, (1Timothy 5:24,25). Paul instructs the Church to choose leaders carefully because sometimes their sins are not obvious ...the same with good deeds... eventually all deed, good or bad, will come out into the open. We pray to make wise decisions as they will follow us for a lifetime. Please pray for families with issues...every day we encounter hurting people from all walks of life.
- 13. But mark this: There will be terrible times in the last days. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boatful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, noy lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than overs of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with them, (2Timothy 3:1-5). Wow sums up our days completely. We pray to be a light in this dark world, giving the hope that is in Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. Please pray for the FCFI schedules and events...pray for workers and for souls as they hear the Good News through the Walking Stick ministry.
- 14. Epaphras, my fellow prisoner in Christ Jesus sends you greetings, (Philemon 23). Epaphras was the founder of the Colossian church and worked to hold it together through the persecution of the Believers. Like Paul, even in prison he was preaching the Gospel and encouraging the saints. We pray to not get discouraged in times of persecution. We pray to reach out to others and encourage them and thus encourage

ourselves. Please pray for the mission trips scheduled through the year as people with willing and giving hearts go out and minister to others in need.

- 15. When God made His promise to Abraham, since there was no one greater for Him to swear by, He swore by Himself, saying, I will surely bless you and give you many descendants, (Hebrews 6:13,14). God's promises are unchanging and trustworthy. His timing is also His own. - 18. As for you, the anointing you received from Him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. - is done. Please pray for a great awakening in our country and the world over as people come in droves to know the Lord as Savior and Lord of their lives.
- 20. But the Lord inflicted serious diseases on Pharaoh and his household because of Abram's wife Sarai, (Genesis 12:17). Abrahams was good but he wasn't perfect. He was afraid Pharaoh would kill him and his people if he said Sarai, was his wife. Trusting God in times of stress is one way we can honor His name. We pray not to be afraid in times of stress and uncertainty but to place our faith in a never-changing Father. Please pray specifically for salvation for men who are husbands, fathers, and grandfathers today. They have such a significant impact on the family, good or bad.
- 21. The Israelites groaned in their slavery and cried out, and their cry for help because of their slavery went up to God. God heard their groaning, and He remembered His covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob. So, God looked on the Israelites and was concerned about them, (Exodus 2:23-25). Moses had fled Egypt as a prince and was living in the dessert as a shepherd. God was teaching him many things he would need in days to come when leading the Israelites in the dessert.
